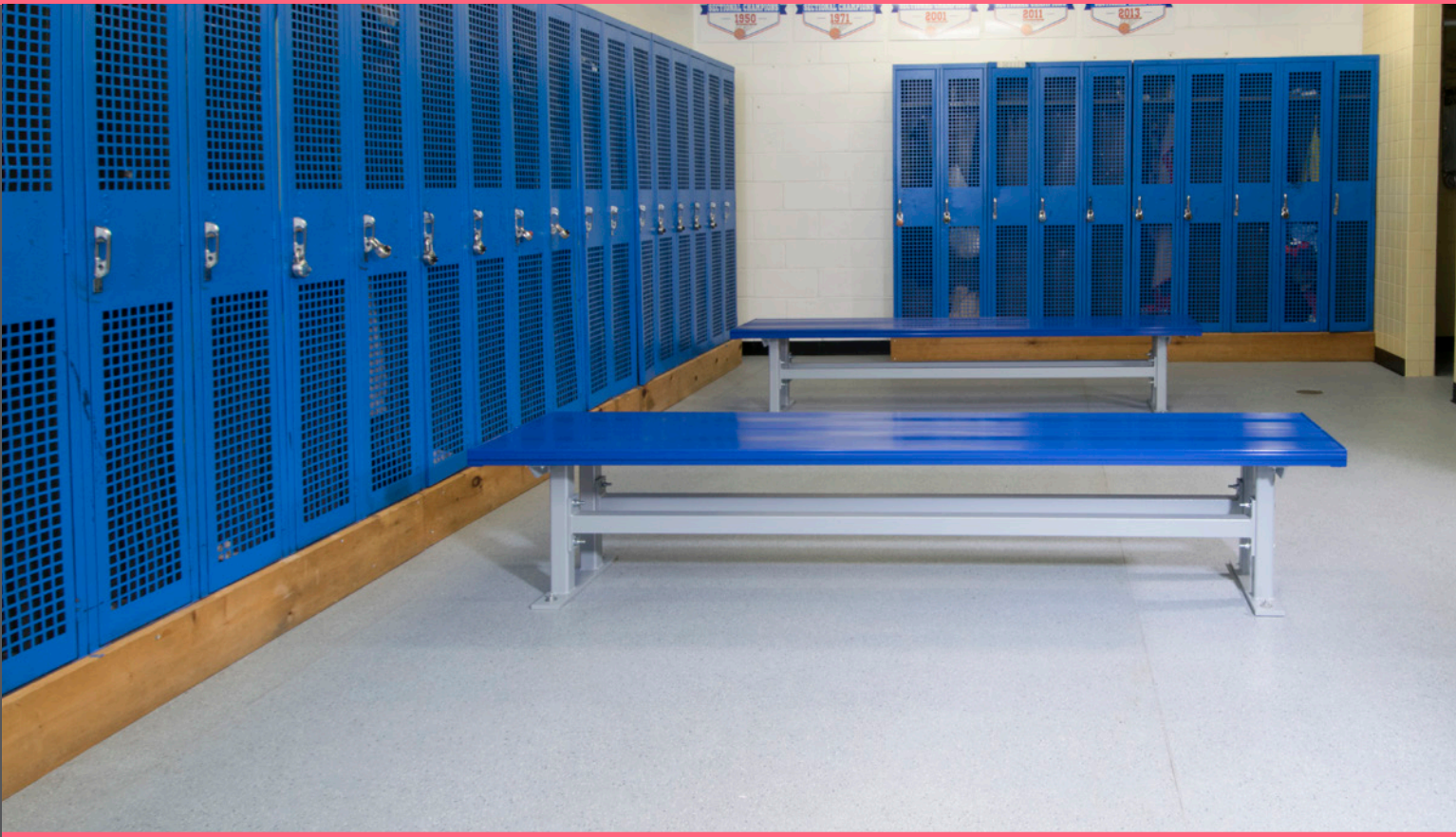

Safety is Paramount for Jonathan Dayton High School Students

Jonathan Dayton High School is part of Springfield Public School system, located in Union County, N.J. Founded in 1934, the school is dedicated to developing each student's body of knowledge, personal character, and high ethical standards, in the hope of giving them the tools needed to succeed in society. The high school believes students are entitled to an intellectually, emotionally, and physically safe environment. In support of this belief statement, Jonathan Dayton High School chose to remodel its locker rooms to ensure the safety of its student population.

In June 2014, Lance Jacobs, the athletic director of Jonathan Dayton High School, decided that the dilapidated 1-inch by 1-inch tiles that covered the school's locker rooms

were no longer a safe environment for the students. They needed to renovate on a limited public school budget. The school's primary specification was a safety flooring made to withstand the wet surfaces, resulting from showers and sinks.

As a result, the school installed 500 square-feet of Elevate Aqueous, a slip resistant safety floor with a designer look that involves minimal maintenance. As part of Ecore Athletic's Elevate family, this premium product is designed for use in common areas that are routinely exposed to wetness and is available in 6-foot, 7-inch rolls.
